ENTRY FORM - SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONALS ONLY

1 Eligibility to play:

This event is co-sanctioned between the GJG Tour and 21golffleague and is open to amateur golfers, both boys and girls **in the age classes:**

GJG Tour players age 12-18 (max. 18 at the start of the event – 4th March, 2019)

21golffleague age 19-21 (max. 21 at the start of the event)

All players need to become a GJG Tour member U18 or 21golffleague member (U21)

All players must be members of a registered golf club

Handicap limit: Boys 5 / Girls 7 (for **S A players Handicap Index** Boys 5 Girls 8)

If a player is not meeting the HCP limits or has no GJG eligibility status, please send an wildcard inquiry to service@globaljuniorgolf.com with latest tournaments results.

The tournament committee has 10 wildcards available.

2 Schedule and Format:

The event takes place at the Rondebosch Golf Club and is a 54 Hole individual stroke play.

Commencing **5th March, 2019 and ending 7th March. 18 Holes per day All rounds will be played AM only**

Official practice round **3rd or 4th March 2019. 3rd PM only and 4th AM up to 13h00.**

South African local players may practice on Sunday so as to attend school on the Monday.

Visiting players may book flights home from 16h30 on Thursday 7th after play. A shuttle service will be available to take players to the airport after play.

3 International Team Competition

An International Team Competition will be held simultaneously over the first 36 holes played. A team consists of 3 players of the same nationality, nominated by a National Federation or GJG. A team can be made up of both boys and girls.

Countries can enter more than 1 team. The team score will be the aggregate score of the best 2 players scores for Rounds 1 and 2 only.

The winner will be the team recording the lowest aggregate scores

4 Membership and entry fee

All South African players must become a member of Global Junior Golf (€100) and pay an entry fee of R500.

Players may register directly on GJG web site and pay the membership fee of €100 and then pay the entry fee of R500 into the SAJI account or pay a full amount of R2000 which will cover both the membership to GJG and the entry fee into the SAJI local bank account. Account details below.

The entry fee includes green fees for the event including a practice round, opening dinner and closing ceremony lunch, lunch on tournament days and water and fruit on the course.
